Winner of the 2011 ArteZ International Jazz Composition Contest in the Netherlands, his genre-shaking compositions can be heard in an array of venues serving classical (Taiwan National Concert Hall), experimental (the Stone NYC) and jazz (Catalina Jazz Club Los Angeles & Flagey Center in Brussels).
